Welcome!

As schools and leaders are emerging from the impact of COVID, desperately hoping this will see an end to bubbles and a greater sense of normality in schools, it would be easy to miss some fundamental changes taking place in education this year:

- The introduction of the Early Career Framework and resultant changes to the induction of new teachers may have passed you by if you do not have any NQTS starting in September - but the next time you do, they will be ECTS: Early Career Teachers, with a **two-year statutory induction** and a requirement for a mentor and a tutor.
- NPQML has been discontinued; NPQSL, NPQH and NPQEL programmes have been adapted in accordance with an evidence base approved by the EEF, and there are now three new NPQs:

Leading Teaching
Leading Behaviour and Culture
Leading Teacher Development
